CALCULATING PEU AND RBH

Percentage of Expected Use (PEU) = $\frac{(\% \ of \ circulation \ of \ subgroup)}{(\% \ of \ subgroup \ in \ total \ holdings)} \times 100$

Ratio of Borrowings to Holdings (RBH) = $\frac{(\% \text{ of ILL in subgroup})}{(\% \text{ of subgroup in total holdings})}$

COMPARING BOOKS AND SCORES

Books

- Scholarly research
- \$45
- Longer Print Runs
- Language important

Scores

- Performance and scholarly research
- \$20–35
- Shorter print runs
- Language unimportant

LIMITATIONS

- No e-books
- Ignores multiple checkouts
- Internal checkouts cause problems
- May not help increase overall circulation
- Some books are non-circulating or used without being checked out
- Hard to estimate cost
- Does not show demand over time
- Does not predict future demand
- Older items have had more time for their circulation to build
